With views to the Canadian Rockies, Panorama is perched high in the Purcell mountains just 18 km west of Invermere, BC.

Panorama is a 3.5-hour drive (311 km) from Calgary International Airport, with daily flights from major European and North American Cities.

The LOC's preferred car rental company is Calgary Budget. Vehicles can be booked at reservations@calgarybudget.com.

Daily shuttles and custom charters from Calgary International Airport to Panorama Mountain Resort can be booked with the LOC at least 14 days prior to arrival with cargo details at racing@panoramaresort.com.



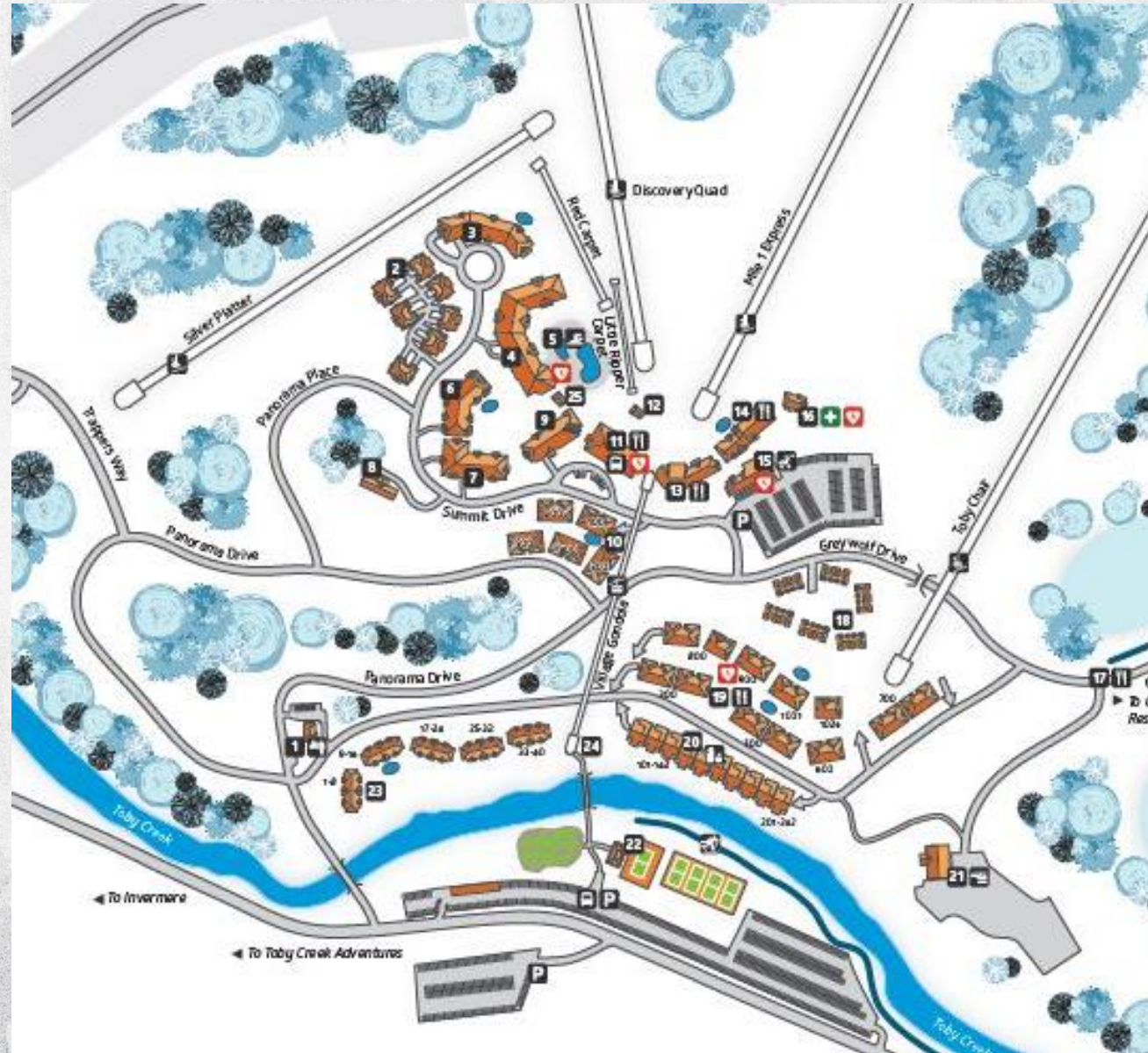
TEAM EXPERIENCE



- **Welcome packages**
 - Upon arrival, teams must check-in the Copper Crown Conference Centre (#15 on the village map).
 - They will receive their accreditation, room keys & lift passes (FIS Passport required).
- **Lodging**
 - A variety of condos, townhomes and hotel rooms between the Upper & Lower Village are available.
 - Accommodation will be assigned by the LOC.
- **Meals**
 - Three (3) daily meals will be served in the Great Hall (#11 on the village map) in compliance with the Provincial Health Order.
 - The LOC is prepared to cater to dietary restrictions.
- **Tuning rooms**
 - All located on-site and easily accessible to teams and their technicians.
- **Team Captains Meetings**
 - The TCMs will be held daily in the Copper Crown.
- **Extra activities** (COVID restrictions dependent):
 - Flower ceremonies in the finish, on competition days.
 - Awards ceremonies in the heart of the Village, on competition days.
 - Opening & Closing ceremonies on-resort.
 - A parade may also take place in Invermere.

TRAINING INFORMATION



Pre-Season training is available at Panorama from November 5th to December 9th, 2021.

Training space (GS & SL only) will be available throughout the championships. The slope (Little Dipper) is near the competition venue.

Gates are included in lane training. The package is offered at a rate of \$100 per athlete for the duration of the event if they wish to train. It should be booked through the LOC at racing@panoramaresort.com.

Alternatively, speed training will be available at Kimberley Alpine Resort (1.5-hour drive from Panorama).





COVID-19 CONSIDERATIONS

The state of the global pandemic next winter will define the protocols for Canada, Alberta and British Columbia.

The rules for entry and quarantine protocols will be mandated by [the Federal Government of Canada](#). As of September 28, all travelers entering must adhere to the [following rules](#):

- Must be fully vaccinated;
- A negative PCR test taken no longer then 72 hours prior to your arrival in Canada;
- [ArriveCAN](#) protocol.

The Provincial Health Orders for [Alberta](#) (teams will land in Calgary, AB) and [British Columbia](#) (championships) are updated every 4-6 weeks. The Local Organizing Committee will work closely with a [BC's Interior Health](#) officer and a [viaSport](#) representative to ensure all current COVID protocol in February and March 2022 are followed.

To receive their JWC Panorama 2022 accreditation, all teams will be required FIS Passports.

The weblink to our full COVID Plan will be sent out in the invitation letter on November 1st, 2021. It will also be uploaded to www.panorama2022.com (note: this is a live document that is updated frequently).





MEDICAL INFORMATION

The Medical Plan will be available at least 6 weeks prior to the championships.

- Fully developed and tested helicopter rescue plan
- Professional Ski Patrol Team
- Five (5) on-hill patrol locations for speed races – Each station will have C-Spine management, trauma packs, oxygen, splinting, airway & pain management.
- A Medical Centre next to the Patrol Centre will be dedicated to WJC teams only.

The [Canadian Center for Ethics in Sport](#) will be responsible for anti-doping testing. The testing facilities will be located 200 meters away from the finish line.





TEST EVENT



The LOC, along with Alpine Canada and the NorAm Committee, had planned to test the full schedule and all events on 3 separate occasions. Due to COVID-19, they did not move forward due to border restrictions but most importantly to ensure the safety of all stakeholders.

[NorAms](#) are scheduled at Panorama Mountain Resort from December 12 to 18, 2021, as a test event.
