Peter Gerdol, Chief Race Director: Main objectives for 2020-21 season:

- Minimize risk
- Workable, balanced calendar
- Requires attentiveness from all
- Reduce overall numbers at each site
- Sölden prepared with very strict covid-19 protocol
- Communication to all parties critical

Jean-Philippe Vulliet, Race Director

- Many summer inspections, most in person
- Beijing inspection in November, very steep and narrow track
- St. Anton, first time in 8 years
- New group of younger women after many retirees, objective will be to lower jumps
- Last season saw several injuries most due to weather conditions

Andreas Kronner, Race Director

- Start/Finish areas will incorporate the colour "bubble" concept, each group will stay within their "bubble" to reduce in person interaction
- No official awards
- Team Captain's meeting will allow one person from each nation

Giulia Candiago, Alpine Women's Media Coordinator

- Press conferences and TV interviews will all be streamed and use of social media paramount, youtube, Instagram, etc.
